The University of Copenhagen – an environment for interdisciplinary aging research

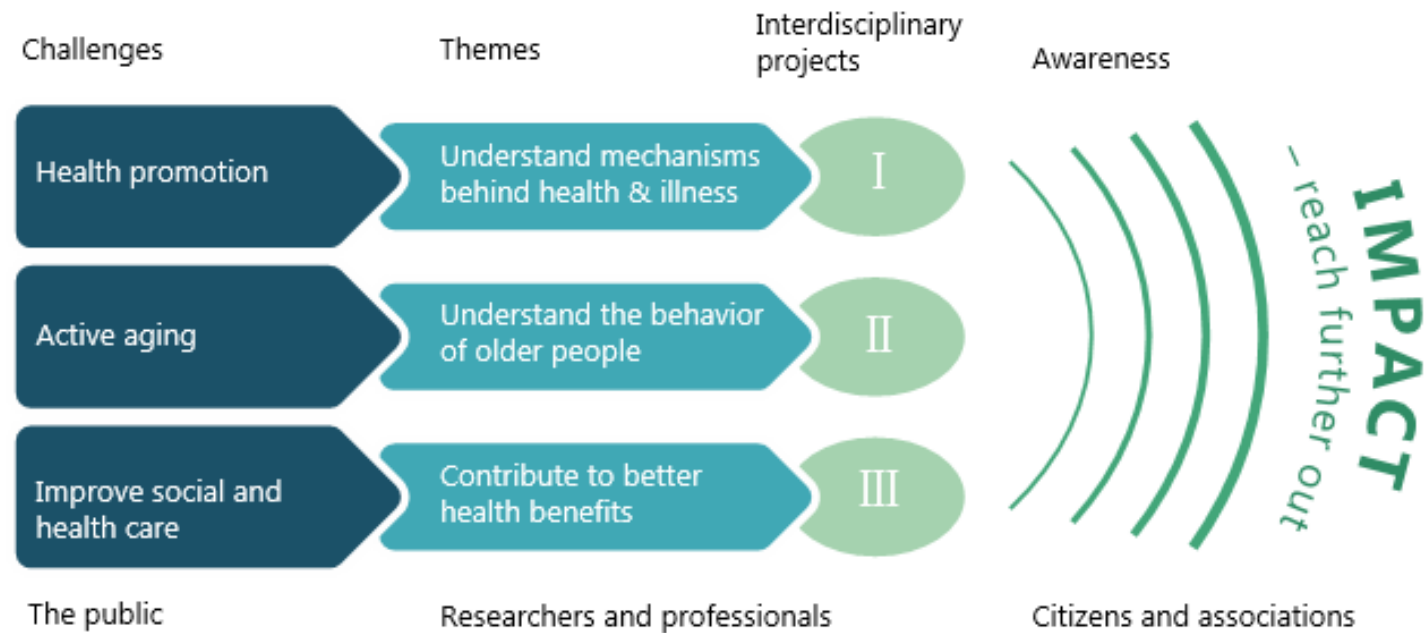
The Center is an interdisciplinary research center
